

HAY MEADOW BURIAL GROUND 2025 STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary). Please note: Hay Meadow Burial Ground only offer funeral directing services in connection with services taking place at Hay Meadow Burial Ground where loved ones are laid to rest. We only offer an unattended service at the Crematorium; however, a service may be held at Hay Meadow Burial Ground before or after the Cremation using our facilities (free of charge) when purchasing an ash burial plot – offering an all-inclusive service.

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Director's charges only)	£1,480
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£620
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care (out of hours may apply)	£195
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises and left naturally resting, using no toxic chemicals.	£235
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from cardboard	£285
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the Funeral Director - fee for each visit (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£50
At a date and time, you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium normally within 15 miles of the Funeral Director's premises in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£95

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Direct Burial at HMBG (Funeral Director's charges only) **£1,385**

Direct Cremation (Funeral Director's charges with the cremation fee)² **£2,025**

* Please note crematorium fees could increase after publishing this information.

FEES YOU MUST Pay HMBG (only) Everyone welcome, same fees for everyone.

For an Attended or Unattended (HMBG) burial funeral, the **burial fee:¹£550**

Hay Meadow Burial Ground burial plots are available from: **£850**

Unattended (HMBG) Direct Burial: Burial plot including the burial fee : **£1,200**

An unattended burial, the funeral may require pallbearers (x4) to be present: **£160**

(Additional charge of £40.00 each if more are required for extra-large coffins)

An Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee: ² Not offered** (Only Direct)

An unattended cremation (Direct): **£545**

Hay Meadow Burial Ground ashes burial plots are available from: **£400**

An Attended or Unattended (HMBG) ash burial, the burial fee: **£95**

*HMBG reserves the right to increase the grave costs for extra-large graves.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
